BioNat Themes

If Mother Nature gives us the disease, Mother Nature also provides the cure to these diseases. The word pharmaceutical comes from the Greek word pharmakeia. The earliest drugstores date to the middle ages. The first known drugstore was opened by Arabian pharmacists in Baghdad in 754, and soon after many more began operating throughout the medieval Islamic world and eventually medieval Europe. By the 19th century many of the drugstores in Europe and North America had eventually developed into larger pharmaceutical companies; the source of all these drugs sold in drug stores was natural products. According to some estimates up to 75% of the drugs being used today have their roots in natural products. Natural products are chemical compounds or substances produced by a living organism that usually have a pharmacological or biological activity for use in drug discovery. The chemical diversity, structural complexity, affordability, lack of substantial toxic effects and inherent biological activity of natural products makes them ideal candidates for new therapeutics. Venoms and toxins often specifically interact with a macromolecular targets in the body. Attention is also devoted to the herbal medicine, plant-derived drugs, phytopharmaceuticals, bioactive proteins, anti-nutrients, synthetic drugs, ethno-pharmacology and biodiversity.



Cyprus is the third largest island at Mediterranean, after Sicily and Sardinia. It is situated at the north-eastern corner of the Mediterranean, at a distance of 300 km north of Egypt, 90 km west of Syria, and 60 km south of Turkey. Cyprus' coastal line is indented and rocky in the north with long sandy beaches in the south. Cyprus has a Mediterranean climate: hot, dry summers from June to September and mild wet winters from November to March, which are separated by short Autumn and Spring seasons. Sunshine is abundant during the whole year, particularly from April to September when the daily average exceeds eleven hours. Winds are on the whole light to moderate. The food of Cyprus reflects the rich and turbulent history of the island and its indelible Greek culture. You will find tastes influenced by the Middle East, Asia Minor and the Venetians, all using fresh local ingredients, herbs, spices and olive oil. 
