


# Doctoral Colloquium, April 13th, 2019

## Call for Papers

We are pleased to announce a call for papers for the doctoral colloquium organised on April 13<sup>th</sup> 2019 at the University of Nicosia. The colloquium seeks to provide the opportunity to doctoral students to present their work in progress, to engage with other doctoral students from different parts of the world, and to receive feedback from fellow students, but also from faculty members and visiting scholars. Students will be able to exchange knowledge, experiences, best practises, advice but also constructive feedback. The colloquium will also be an opportunity for students to expand their network with other students and experienced scholars, possibly kick-starting collaborations for publications. Faculty members from UNic and from other Universities will also share their knowledge about doctoral research and potential academic careers and will be able to offer useful insights on how to complete a PhD in a successful way.

Notification of acceptance: 18th March 2019

Deadline for registration: 29th March 2019

Reduced participation fee for accompanying persons (including supervisors): €80

IMPORTANT: All payments must be made by 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019 the latest in order for notification of acceptance to still be valid.

#### **Submission Process**

Please send your single authored extended abstract (max. 5 pages, Times New Roman 12- font, 1.5 line space, and 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin all around) including the following titles:

- 1. Introduction (including research gap and associated research questions)
- 2. Relevance / contribution of proposed research (could be theoretical, empirical, practical)
- 3. Theoretical framework (key literature you are considering and basing your research on)
- 4. Methodological approach/es and method/s proposed or used
- 5. Empirical findings (if any yet)
- 6. Discussion and conclusions (if any yet)
- 7. References
