Short description of activity:

The Trainee will give support to the Unit Safety and Sustainability of Buildings where he/she will be integrated in a team dealing with the protection of buildings and other physical infrastructures against explosions due to terrorist attacks or accidents.

Classical risk approaches are well established for natural and man-made non-intentional hazards like earthquakes. The risk of terrorism as an intentional hazard is particular and there is a lack of publicly available approaches. The unit has long experience in dealing with event based data related to terrorism. However, using only data of past terrorist events to determine the risk of terrorism is not sufficient. Adding data to the analysis could improve the risk indicator.

The trainee will (a) review the data sources concerning terrorism that are freely available and identify possible indicators and related data sets (b) contribute to the statistical analysis of the identified indicators; and (c) contribute to the construction of a more complex structure, such as a terrorism indicator or scoreboard.
