About the Hospital

Our University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust is a Teaching Hospital, linked to the London University and is also the Cancer Centre for South Essex which is part of the Essex Cancer network. This busy DGH serves a population of 338,800. They currently employ about 4,500 wte staff with a total complement of 190 Consultant staff.

Obstetrics and Gynaecology Department

The Obstetrics and Gynaecology Department provides excellent care to all women within the area. This has been recently evidenced by several achievements including top 25% rating in the Healthcare Commission review for maternity services, and a good Gynaecological Oncology Cancer Peer Review. The Directorate is the designated Gynaecological Cancer Centre for South Essex and also provides a wide variety of expertise in gynaecology.

The day-to-day management of the department is assumed by the Head of Midwifery & Gynaecology, Head of Paediatrics and the General Manager, supported by a team of matrons and junior service managers. All Managers meet monthly with the Consultants to ensure a cohesive management strategy. There are also regular meetings with junior doctors. Support for the department is also provided by clinical nurse specialists in oncology, colposcopy and early pregnancy. Clinical governance is co-ordinated by a risk manager with a team of supervisors of midwives. As an employee of the Trust the doctor will work in close co-operation with all departments and other medical, professional and managerial colleagues to provide high quality healthcare to the Trust's patients.

The hospital has Associate University status. Consequently the training of medical students, junior hospital doctors, nurses and physiotherapists has a high priority. The new colleague will be actively encouraged to pursue any interest in this area. Clinical Governance is a major part of our daily practice. The hospital is at the forefront of providing same, with a separate department and allocated clinical and ancillary staff to service same.

There is a well-stocked medical library with audio-visual teaching aids, CD-ROM and a full time librarian. The library has a Medline facility. There is a thriving Postgraduate Medical Centre with regular clinical meetings and a general education programme.
