Duties and qualifications

As a **Nurse in General Care** you will work independently and as part of the care team with responsibility for nursing within patient related activities.

The work with patients will consist of assessment, treatment and care giving activities. Other tasks are documentation according to relevant law, guidelines and specific care-giving tasks for nurses in the wards.

The Surgical unit in Sunderby Hospital is the hospital's largest unit with 110 employees.

The unit forms part of the Anaesthesia / Surgical / ICU Department . We perform about 10,000 operations a year, about 60% being performed on an outpatient basis while the remainder are inpatient procedures. We are divided into sections and serve all surgical clinics, such as surgery, urology, orthopaedics, women's healthcare, ENT, etc

For a position as an operating room nurse you are a registered nurse in an EU/EEA country with specialisation in operating theatre tasks and interested in advancing your professional development and knowledge of the surgical environment. We work in multidisciplinary teams of physicians, surgical nurses, nurse anaesthetists and nurses.
