
War in Ukraine

A new reality for the certificate of birth for a kid from Ukraine, if her parents are killed or this small Ukrainian girl died, kidnaped or get lost....

- 287 children are killed and more than 508 are injured
- 4113 civilians are killed, plus 22 000 in Mariupol
- 4916 civilians are injured
- 1,4 mln: forced to go to russia
- 3 mln. people: in the territories under invasion
- 8.4 million people displaced by the war in Ukraine over 6,8 mln. abroad
- 1972 education institutions have suffered bombing and shelling
- 194 educational institutions have been destroyed completely

Teacher of the pedagogical college has been shot and many other academics died as civilians defending Ukraine...

- All Ukraine is under attack every day and night!!!
- There are many cities destroyed and some are under invasion!!!
- Over 500 hospitals and 350 cultural centers are damaged/destroyed
- Travel/Evacuation within Ukraine/out of Ukraine not safe
- Access of the university teachers, researchers and staff limited/absent
- Access of the students to the universities limited/absent
- Universities contacts and documents not available/ destroyed/relocated
- Universities infrastructures for digital/blended education partially not available/destroyed/relocated
- Payments are under delay.

International Relation Officers, Erasmus+ Coordinators, EU & other international project teams, their families, Erasmus students – are in danger at the territories under invasion...

In spite of the war, the education started on 14 March in distance/blended learning format!!! 24 regions of Ukraine are providing higher education in distance format; 12 – in blended format!!!

Another Ukrainian was killed just because of the EU flag on his keys lace...

- More sanctions required against the russian federation and belarus, including academic cooperation and research at individual level!!!
- Ukrainians are defending the identity and values strongly, protesting in front of tanks and guns in the cities under invasion vs russians benefiting form the opportunities abroad!!!
- 280 rectors of universities in the russian federation signed a letter in support of the russian aggression against Ukraine benefited from EU's Programmes!
- russians who behaved unhuman torturing Ukrainians, raping and kill women and kids were educated in the period of <u>Bologna Process implementation</u> in russia and active support of EU to russian universities, staff, students and young people!!!
- EU funded Programmes impact on russian higher education and youth since 1993 must be initiated: investment into people2people contacts, quality of the European Studies etc...

Over 2700 cruise missiles were targeted by russians to the Ukrainian territory recognised by the international law!!!





Sanctions

Sanctions - #Erasmuswithoutrussia — at the link, projects with russia and belarus are terminal

The cooperation with their organisations funded by the state budget is NOT eligible

The individual opportunities for russians/belorusions*

are still eligible though such opportunities are based on the interinstitutional

cooperation which is NOT eligible by the European Commission sanctions!

Based on its Academic/organizational Freedom it is up to the Erasmus Universities and other organisations on how to apply it, please do the right choice – choose Ukraine, we are defending the future of Europe!

Stop recognition of russian diplomas, they are not in Bologna Process any more!

PLEASE NOT provide similarities via joint **support** platforms for Ukrainians, Russians, and Belarusians: do not equal those suffering from a bloody war with those whose governments directly support war and terrorism – 'victims of war' ≠ 'victims of totalitarian regime'.

Ukrainians are not refugees – not refused by our country... but temporary relocated/protected



Modern and innovative Kharkiv Specialised School #17 was not a military target as well as 194 other !!!

- Support to safety of people: temporarily displaced/relocated (internally and internationally).
- Humanitarian aid to the Ukrainian educational institutions who host the temporarily relocated people and institutions. Psychological support is needed too!
- Access to the education process, platforms, servers relocation, infrastructure rebuilding, simulators, equipment for labs etc.
- Open resources (open university prototype) European University Alliances piloting
- Support to the educational and research institutions:

Staff – safe place to live/job, mobility grants, in-service training, job shadowing, staff weeks, join the research&projects teams, new proposals writing, curricula modernisation, new methodologies and technologies, preparation of double programmes, development courses in foreign languages, language courses, trainings for proposals writing, free access to join professional associations etc.

Students – summer schools for students, physical/virtual exchanges, laptops, Internet access, access

Support to respond the needs

- Funding mobility to staff, students&youth: already on Erasmus/grants for new
- Virtual exchanges/mobility physical mobility is limited to some staff/students; lack or startle
- Joint webinar on professional topics/ methodologies: in-service training, dialogue/exchange.
- Develop a Certificate with list of learning outcomes for staff and students recognition!!!
- Opportunities to study in parallel on Erasmus and at home university hybrid mobility
- #<u>StudyForUkraine with #ESNKyiv</u> initiative!
- No brain drain!!! Instead:
- Ukrainian students and staff could become Ambassadors of their University for more cooperation, visiting several faculties and universities in the city where they are promoting the University and Ukraine!!!
- Additional task for all Ukrainians abroad: help students to contact their home university!
- It is critical, many of students are lost and after one failure to contact their university do not try again! Help other universities too!!!
- We are all Ukrainians!

	Eligible activities						
	 The activities have to take place at the beneficiary HEI. In cases when, due to the war, the sending organisation cannot be involved in the activity, the beneficiary HEI is the only HEI involved in the organisation of the mobility, except for traineeships outside of the HEI. 						
	 For students: mobility for studies and mobility for traineeships. For traineeships this also includes traineeships for recent graduates (the term students will include them in these special provisions. In these cases, the beneficiary institution has to arrange the traineeships. The trainees are hosted either at the beneficiary HEI or, in a non-HEI organisation in the same country (using the KA107 learning agreement for incoming trainees). In the latter case, the traineeship mobility is to be funded by the beneficiary HEI. 						
	 For staff: mobility for teaching (including invited staff from non-HEI organisations) and mobility for training. 						
	Application						
	 Participants apply directly to the beneficiary HEI in or through which they would like to undertake a mobility. There is no need for an inter-institutional agreement. 						
	There is no need for nominations The last is no need for nominations.						
	 The learning agreement/staff mobility agreement is signed only between the participant and the receiving institution (plus with the traineeship hosting organisation if it is not the HEI).





Challenges for cooperation under projects

- To find contact information of the partners from Ukraine
- Force Majeure Circumstances: suspend or continue with redesigning – GRANT AGREEMENT
- Staff and students safety killed, wounded, unsafe but is working/studying: within Ukraine, from the shelters, from the Defense Army, from temporary occupied territory of Ukraine, from abroad
- Activities implementation: not possible, possible with delay, changes required etc.
- Destroyed or damaged premises and equipment
- No access to reporting documents
- Blocked or delayed payments

Contact your partners, discuss the situation and make the decision together! Inform your project coordinator & officer

Contact NEO – Ukraine (24/7), put in copy during correspondence!!!

If it is not possible to contact your partners — inform urgently NEO — Ukraine about it to help!!!

Staff Cost and other payments delays

- Force Majeure Circumstances: suspend or continue with redesigning safety
- Grant Agreement includes an Article on the Force Majeure Circumstances.
- Suspension: an official letter must be issued and sent to EACEA signed by the authorized person and project coordinator.



- Continuation of activities, redesign and prolongation of the eligibility flexibility from European Commission: an official letter with explanation of the situation in the project with detailed justification must be issued and sent to EACEA signed by the authorized person and project coordinator plus Annexes
- Annexes with updated Work Plan, equipment and budget reallocation, if required.
- 10% flexibility for staff: inform EACEA with the additional outcomes to be produced. All in all staff cost should not exceed 44% of the total grant See your Grant Agreement.
- Staff cost, Travel&Cost of Stay, Equipment and subcontracting, currency payments are blocked or delayed state treasury and bank (solutions due to New Regulation at the link, further legislation changes are required).
- For Equipment purchase, if funds are not in Ukraine: 3 party agreements is a solution





Planning additional activities

Planning of additional activities: e.g. summer schools, TOT, hybrid conferences

- Safety of people
- Quality of Outcomes
- Possibility for Offline events abroad: invitation from hosts and internal order for business trip

UA staff from Ukraine, if safe zone trip:

- Payment for Cost of Stay is possible/eligible
- Travel cost is possible/eligible
- Crossing the border for females. Males only if under 18 / above 60 or exceptions

UA staff abroad could travel within Europe:

- Payment for Cost of Stay is possible/eligible
- Travel cost is challenging* from the home HEIs account/could be covered by cost of stay amount
- Possible direct purchase of tickets by coordinating university
- In some countries the travel is free of charge by certain trains for Ukrainians
- Travel cost for project in this case will be eligible based on the effective price





The justification of the place of departure and return, should be explained in the supporting documents to the order of the rector

Unit Cost for Business Trip

- The Unit for the Travel cost of the project budget in this case will be eligible based on the effective price
- E.g.

The event is in Poland

- Distance calculator from Lviv to Warsaw: 180 Euro
- The Ukrainian team representative is in Madrid under temporary protection or other Erasmus
- Distance calculator from Madrid to Warsaw: 360 Euro

For the reporting to EACEA – it goes as 180 Euro.

Please check if there are savings under the unit cost in your Ukrainian partners and they may receive the payment of the real price of the ticket!

NO DOUBLE FUNDING!!!

If the car is used for the travel, there are specific requirements.







Equipment purchase and Subcontracting

Modern and innovative Kharkiv Karasin National University was not a military target as well as other 194!!!



Equipment: funds at UA partner university account:

- Not started the tendering
- Not finalised the tendering
- Finalised tendering not paid/not delivered/installed

Equipment: funds at EU partner university account:

- 3 party agreement is a solution
- Deliver if possible and when the relative safety is confirmed

Subcontracting:

- Check the eligibility with EACEA
- Check if you need to make changes and send the justification to EACEA project office

Currency payments/transfers

Currently blocked – legislation changes are required







Communicate!

Coordinators:

- Constant communication with/between partners about the situation
- Updating EACEA about the situation: changes, delays, deviation
- Discuss the suspension/redesign/risks between partners agree on approach
- Send official letter to EACEA duly signed: on suspension/prolongation/deviation
- Contact/update NEO Ukraine and put in copy in your correspondence
 Ukrainian partners:
- If you need urgent help, do not hesitate urgently contact your NEO/ partners When relatively safe and have the access to Internet:
- Contact your partners/coordinator/NEO team for updates on the project situation.
- Communicate to NEO team about the challenges/problems/
- If you do not have contacts or failed to contact the management of your university, contact NEO
- Provide NEO Ukraine contact below to your colleagues, partners







HOW YOU CAN HELP

Challenges for cooperation under Mobility Projects

- To find contact information of the HEIs to discuss support needed
- Force Majeure Circumstances: suspend or continue with redesigning
 - urgently inform your project coordinator & officer
- Contact NEO Ukraine, put in copy during correspondence, we are here to help!!!
- Staff safety, activities delays, changes, damages, new workplan/ activities etc.
- Payments delay, state treasury and banks issues etc. However changes to Regulation adopted already to allow limited payments under the projects — <u>New Regulation at the link</u>
- To receive the permission from the management for staff&students mobility
- To apply flexibility within Ukrainian HEIs:
 - updates for the Internal Regulations on the International Cooperation/Mobility is required
 - Nomination vs Selection procedures updates if needed
 - Signatures of Interinstitutional Agreements
 - Explanation to the Erasmus+ partners on the recognition mechanisms etc.


Challenges for Mobility Projects

- Institutional regulation for Mobility does not reflect the war time!
- Not ready/able to apply flexibility
- Recognition by the EU universities of prior study or belonging to the university without the documents which were lost/destroyed during war/ recognition for mobility periods
- Study or Traineeship for 1st year students, longer period of semester 4th year students
- Teaching, Training, Job shadowing for staff
- Passport/visa and crossing the border
- The male students and staff 18-60 years old are <u>not allowed to cross the border</u> with some <u>exceptions!!!</u>

Additional conditions and docs are required:

Crossing border by <u>male students and staff</u> during Martial Law is regulated by the Decree of the President of Ukraine of 24.02.2022 Nº 64/2022 «On the imposition of martial law in Ukraine». The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine Regulation Nº 264 dated as of 12/03/2022 (https://zakon.rada.gov.ua/laws/show/264-2022-%D0%BF#Text) regulated exceptions which include among other things: "... students for studying abroad in full-time or dual forms of education; people with disabilities and accompanying persons..." Video - https://fb.watch/dfCkWr1BYq/

They need to have obligatory the military center certificate about the reason why they are not at the military service*.







Steps to do

- Map the need of the support: staff, students, institution
- Discuss with current projects teams what can be done within their activities
- What should be redesigned and apply to EACEA, NA or partners for approval (put NEO in copy)
- Formulate the needs into the short projects up to 2 pages: objectives, activities, outcomes, partnership, resources required
- Prepare the e-letter to the partners existing or new
- Ask what are the opportunities within and above Erasmus+
- Send the letters and agree on the virtual/physical meetings to discuss
- Share you university needs with your staff and students who are abroad to promote these ideas widely in their universities and others in the city
- Request your staff abroad to organise a project writing together with their host partners universities to apply for Erasmus+, Horizon Europe etc. (or proposal writing trainings).
- Contact NEO Ukraine for (group) consultation to work out on the proposals with concrete ideas.




